OFFICIAL BULLETIN

1. TITLE OF MATCH: WASHINGTON STATE SERVICE RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIPS

PLACE AND DATE: SPOKANE, WA 24 SEPTEMBER 1995

2. NUMBER OF COMPETITORS: 26 (25 non-Distinguished competitors)
(1 other competitors)

3. CONDITIONS GOVERNING MATCH:

a. RULES: This match was governed by the rules prescribed by the National Board for the Promotion of Rifle Practice. (see AR 920-30, AR 350-6 and AR 672-5-1).

b. OPEN TO: Any citizen of the United States 16 years of age or older. (Distinguished personnel are eligible to compete for place awards only. However, if range facilities limit the number of entries which can be accepted, priority will be given to non-Distinguished competitors).

c. COURSE OF FIRE: National Match Course

FIRST STAGE -- slow fire, 200 yards; target, short range, competitive (SR). 10 shots, standing, 1 minute per shot. The sling must be attached to the rifle but may not be used for support.

Second Stage -- Sustained fire, 200 yards; target, short range competitive (SR). 10 shots, sitting or kneeling from standing; 60 seconds firing time.

Third Stage -- Sustained fire, 300 yards; new, target, short range competitive (SR-3). 10 shots, prone from standing; 70 seconds firing time.

Fourth Stage -- Slow fire, 600 yards; target, new, midrange, competitive (MR-1). 20 shots, prone; 1 minute per shot.

d. ARM: US Rifle, Caliber .30M1/M1NM; US Rifle, Caliber 7.62mm M1/M1NM; US Rifle, Caliber 7.62mm M14M/M14nm; or Civilian Equivalent, having not less than 4 1/2 pound trigger pull, with standard stock and sights as issued; or the US Caliber 5.56mm M16 series or commercial equivalent, as prescribed for use in the National Matches.

e. AMMUNITION: All ammunition used must be pointed tip, full metal jacket. The projectile may have a "ballistic" hollow point such as that used in the current Military M852 style 7.62 arsenal match round. Ammunition may be either commercial manufactured or handloads.
