The Championship was organized in support of **Camp Patriot** www.camppatriot.org , a local grass roots organization dedicated to providing outdoor recreational opportunities to our disabled veterans.

On Friday **Carl Taylor**, former Marine Scout/Sniper and current government & law enforcement trainer donated his time to host a wind reading clinic & practical exercise for this weekend's competitors; proceeds from the clinic were donated to Camp Patriot. After the wind clinic the participants shot a "last man standing" match from 1000 yards under challenging wind conditions; Clint Sharp defended the honor of the United States Army by winning the match and graciously donating his winnings to Camp Patriot. His donation was matched by the High Power association, with an additional donation made by Tom Halecki.

George Crawford from **Crawford Enterprises**, Jeff Hertzell from **Tradewind Services**, and Brian Humann from the **Rattlesnake Ordnance Company** donated an AR-15 to be raffled off in support of Camp Patriot.
