## Scott Lorenz wins and two distinguish at the 2012 State Outdoor Pistol Championship

Scott Lorenz won the Stoppel Trophy and this year's State Outdoor Pistol Championship on a beautiful, sunny weekend in late September. The championship was held on September 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> at Paul Bunyan Rifle & Sportsman's Club, in Puyallup. This is not Scott's first state title. He last won in both 2005 and 2006. This championship was one of the largest, however, with 38 competitors shooting over the two day match. Competitors traveled from all over the state to participate. CMP, NRA distinguished revolver and our state's EIC matches were also held. Scott and Bill Freyfogle "legged out" in the EIC matches!

\*Scott Lorenz and Bill Freyfogle won their distinguished honors at this championship. Scott is now an NRA distinguished revolver shot, and Bill Freyfogle is a Washington State distinguished pistol shot. Bill won both his bronze state medal and his silver state medal back in 2004, for the 22 and the centerfire legs of the state distinguished program. The national match course with his 45 finally came together, and he is now the 14<sup>th</sup> state distinguished pistol shot.

# Match Report – Dan Lowe Sweeps the 2012 Fall SchÜtzenfest

Every year on the last weekend in September the Tacoma Rifle and Revolver Club hosts the Fall SchÜtzenfest, consisting of the Washington State Outdoor International Rifle Championship and an informal 100 shot standing match. The Fall SchÜtzenfest signals the end of the year’s outdoor smallbore rifle season.

## Washington State Outdoor International Rifle Championship

The Outdoor International Rifle Championship consists of two separate matches: a 60 shot prone (English) match and a 120 shot 3-position match where 40 shots are fired in each of the three positions - prone, standing, and kneeling. The English and 3-position matches are registered by USA Shooting, the governing body for Olympic style shooting in the U.S.

The championship was fired on Saturday September 22. 39 shooters competed, requiring 2 relays. Conditions were good, with favorable light and generally light winds.

### English Match

The championship begins with the English match. The match was won by Dan Lowe edging out Spencer Upham by one point on the final target, which was squeezed in after the 3x40 match in fading daylight. Scores (out of 600 possible) are summarized below as follows:

### 3 – Position Match

The score for the first 40 shots of the English Match carry over to the 3-position match. Randi Loudin fired the top standing score of 370x400. For the aggregate, Dan Lowe opened up a 3 point lead over Spencer Upham by firing a standing score of 365x400. Dan and Spencer battled it out in the kneeling stage for the match and State Championship. Dan shot a 387 to win the State crown by 5 points over Spencer.
