2012 3-Position Air Rifle Junior Olympic Championship Results

This article reports on the 2012 Washington 3-Position Air Rifle (3PAR) Junior Olympic Championship held in February 2011. Shooters were competing for slots in the National 3PAR Junior Olympic Championship to be held at Anniston, Alabama in late June and early July. The 3PAR Junior Olympics are sanctioned by the Civilian Marksmanship Program.

All shooting is done at 10 meters with 20 shots being fired in each of the prone, standing, and kneeling positions. The match was shot in Spokane on the east side and Olympia on the west side. The Orion electronic scoring system was used to score targets. Scores from the east and west sides were then combined and rankings determined. Match results are divided into two classes based on the shooter's equipment – precision and sporter. Individual scores were combined for team matches. A total of 29 shooters competed in the sporter class and 62 in the precision class.

Scores for boys and girls are combined for medals. Ties are broken first by inner tens and then by the score of the second kneeling 10 shot string.
